CASE STUDY

Trump Tower III — Sunny Isles Beach

Recessed Crestron solar shades and a Crestron drapery track · commissioned into the residence's Control4 system.



A private residence at Trump Tower III, 15811 Collins Avenue in Sunny Isles Beach – glass on three sides and the Atlantic filling every one of them. The brief was simple to say and hard to build: control the glare and the heat **without putting anything on the ceiling**. Every treatment in the home is recessed — rollers and drapery track alike disappear into pockets, so from inside the rooms there is no fascia, no bracket, no tube. The hardware is **Crestron** throughout; the residence runs on **Control4**, and the shading was commissioned into its existing scenes and keypads alongside the home's AV partner.

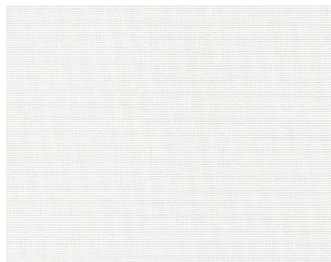

LIVING SPACES	Crestron motorized roller shades — Mermet E Screen 5% White/White (CSF-ESC02-05), recessed pockets throughout
PRIMARY SUITE	Crestron motorized drapery track — white sheer by Fabricut, pocketed wall to wall
THE HARD PART	A stepped and curved facade including an arched bay — every opening templated individually, none off a schedule
INTEGRATION	Crestron shading commissioned into the residence's existing Control4 system, with the home's AV partner
DELIVERY	Measured, templated, fabricated, installed and commissioned by our own team — direct with the owner

The detail that mattered

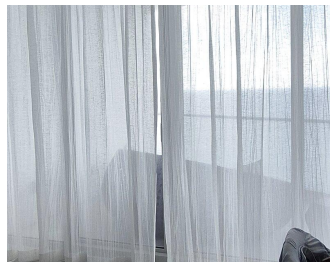
The facade steps and curves as it turns the corner of the tower, and one bay is a true arch — almost no two openings shared a width, a sill line or a wall angle. Every pocket had to be set out so the fabric hangs plumb on a wall that is not square to the glass, and sequenced with the ceiling trades before the drywall closed.
